January 2020 Arbiter Remuneration Rates

In accordance with NWPTA Division C: Bid Protest Mechanism, Schedule 3 Operational Cost Awards Article 7(5), Arbiter Remuneration, there is an annual inflationary increase linked to the Consumer Price Index (CPI) rate from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

(Remuneration increased linked to 2019 CPI rate: 1.9% (Statistics Canada))

Paragraph 3: Individuals sitting as arbiters are entitled to charge up to a maximum of \$127.38 per hour, to a maximum of \$1019.04 per day for all work required to be undertaken by them while carrying out their duties as arbiter, commencing as of the time they are officially appointed to a Bid Protest constituted under this Division C: Bid Protest Mechanism.
